

ENGLISH

We start the term by reading and exploring poetry that uses pattern and rhyme to entertain the reader before writing our own poem. We will then use the picture book, 'Leon and the Place Between', as stimulus to write our own imaginative character and setting descriptions. In the first half term, there will be a strong focus on consolidating grammar, punctuation, spelling and handwriting skills from Key Stage 1. In the second part of the term, we will move on to writing to inform and learn how to write a clear and informative non-chronological reports about hedgehogs and local wildlife.

SCIENCE / DT

In Science, we will learn about skeletons and muscles, and the nutrition the body needs. Later in the term, we will learn about Light—how we see, how light is reflected and how shadows are formed. In DT, we will use construction materials, tools and skills to make packaging for different purposes.

COMPUTING

We will learn how computer networks move data from one place to another. We will then learn how to create loops, make animations and program games using Scratch.

PE

In the first half term, we will learn gymnastics, developing our flexibility and our technique. In the second half term, we will have fun learning how to play Tri-Golf. 3CF have swimming on Monday afternoon until Christmas.

PSHE

In PSHE this term, we will explore the questions: 'How can I be a good friend?' and 'What are families like?'.

In Geography we will make maps showing some of the key physical and human features of the village and identify Heaton's place within Bradford, Yorkshire and the U.K. Later in the term, we will learn how Heaton has changed over time, research local landmarks and create timelines.

MATHS

We start with Place Value - representing, ordering and using ordering numbers up to 1000. Next, we will build on our Year 2 addition and subtraction skills to learn how to calculate using up to 3 digits with exchanging. We will begin to use inverse calculations. We will use Times Tables Rock Stars to practise number facts.

RE

We start by learning what it means to be a Hindu in Britain today. We then explore the deeper meaning of religious festivals in different world faiths.

ART / MUSIC

In Art, we begin by 'Telling Stories through Making'. We will study famous writers and illustrators, and respond to their work using 3D media to convey character, narrative and context. Later, we will sew, cut and join to make collage work influenced by textile artists. We will also use screen printing to print 2D shapes. In Music, we will use Charanga to learn the songs like 'Let Your Spirit Fly' and also to learn to play the glockenspiels. We will focus on playing, reading and composing with the musical notes C, D, E and F.
