ENGLISH

During the first half term, we will focus on writing to inform. We will write diary entries and instructions. We will also read and explore poetry. In the second half term, we will begin by writing descriptive texts and move on to writing dialogue, with accurate punctuation.

RE

We will start the term by learning what it means to be a Hindu in Britain today. We will focus on Hinduism and Christianity but draw on our knowledge of other faiths. Later on, we will explore how and why believers show their commitment during the journey of life.

HISTORY /GEOGRAPHY/MFL /SCIENCE

In History, we will learn about the Anglo-Saxons and Vikings, and how they influenced Britain of today. Our learning will include map work of the UK and Europe as well as historical research.

In Spanish we will learn the four seasons of the year along with a key feature for each season. We will then revise fruit and learn 10 common vegetables in Spanish. In Science, we will be developing our scientific enquiry skills and grouping and classifying living things. After this, we will focus on biology and data collection.
