

ENGLISH

This half term we will be looking at writing to persuade. We will be writing informal persuasive letters.

Next half term we will be writing to inform, focusing on writing a report about the water cycle.

PE

In PE we will be learning about and playing netball.

We will also be working on our fitness, doing circuit training and other short-burst activities.

MATHS

This term and next we will be focusing on:

- Multiplication
- Division
- Length and perimeter
- Fractions
- Decimals

RE

In the first half term, our topic theme is 'What is it like to follow God?' We will be exploring this question through the stories of Noah and Abraham.

In the second half term, our topic will be Salvation. We will explore the question, 'Why do Christians Call the Day Jesus Died Good Friday?'

COMPUTING
